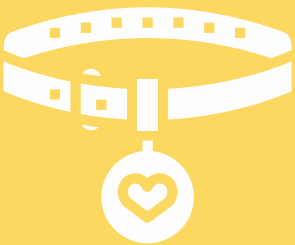




# Emergency Pet Preparedness

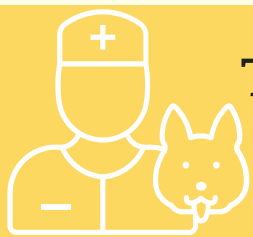

## Stay Informed

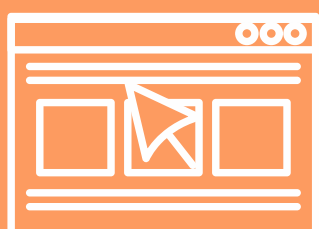
Most emergencies will all be treated the same, but it is important to stay informed.
